Course outline:

This seminar introduces graduate students to current research in geometry, topology, mathematical physics, and in other areas of mathematics. An invited speaker will lead an informal discussion, followed by an elementary talk giving an introduction to the basic examples and main motivation for the research discussed, and aimed at graduate students. The speaker will then present a formal research talk open to all faculty and students, followed by questions and further discussion.
